The Port of Clarkston is seeking proposals from qualified individuals/firms for cultural assessment services, specifically monitoring, in connection with the Port's northwest Clarkston Heights Fiber-to-the-Home project in Clarkston, WA. The detailed RFP can be found at www.portofclarkston.com.

Proposals must be in writing and address each of the elements covered in the detailed Request for Proposal (RFP) which includes both qualifications and costs to perform the work. Submittals should be delivered per instructions by 3 pm, August 2, 2022.
